

Animal circle

Primary game

Aims:

- to talk about wild animals;
- to classify animals according their group (mammals, reptiles, birds, insects) and name their habitat;
- to make questions and answers about animals ("What animal is it?", "Where does it live?").

Preparation:

- pupils cut from magazines out pictures with different animals and glue them on a big circle made from cardboard;
- the animal names are written in English on a smaller circle which is pinned over the big circle.
- Color cards. Task for each color:
 - Green: call an animal.
 - yellow: spin the circle;
 - red: ask a question;
 - blue: answer the question

Procedure:

- I. Pupils draw a color card (red, yellow, green)
- II. The pupil with the green card calls for an animal: "Find the bear on circle!"
- III. The one with a yellow card spins the circle until the word matches with the animal and says – "This is the bear."
- IV. The pupil with a red card asks:
 - "What animal is it?"
- V. The pupil with blue card has to answer:
 - "It's a mammal."
