

How Polish kite has been created?



CLIL Mascot was created in 3 days in the group of three-year old children named "Bears". Firstly, we made wooden structure, on which we put red cloth. Children decided that tail of the kite also will be in our national colours - white and red. Finally, it was a time to decorate our mascot! Forest!" and then they made sun, clouds and mountains from colored paper.

Because Poland is famous of delicious apples, it was necessary to put them on our "map of Poland" in form of branch with fruits. While we were decorating our mascot, we could not forget of animals. There are also pictures of horses bred in Great Poland, storks and bisons from our beautiful north-eastern forests.
