







The Wild Goat-Le Chamois



The wild goat is a **mammal**. It eats **grass**, **berries** and **tree bark**; it is **herbivore**.

It lives in the **rocks** of our **mountains**: the **Alps**.

It is **sure-footed**. It lives in **packs**.

Females usually give birth to **one baby chamois**.

It can live about **14 to 25 years**.

In spring, the **fur** is **brown**. In summer, it **loses** it and in the winter it becomes **black**.

The predators of the wild goat are the **hunters**, the **eagle**, the **fox** and the **wolf**.

When it is in **danger**, it makes a **little noise**.


VENN DIAGRAM: COMPARING A WOLF AND A WILD GOAT

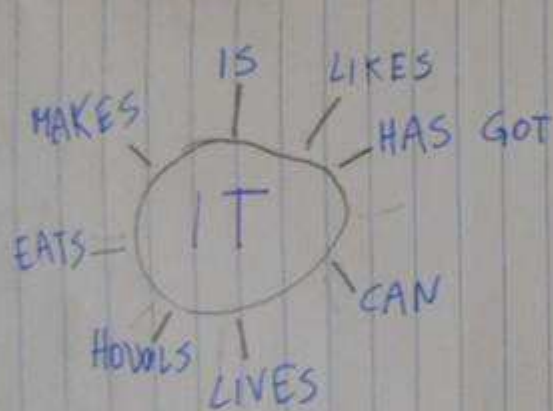


Hedgehogs are	small animals.

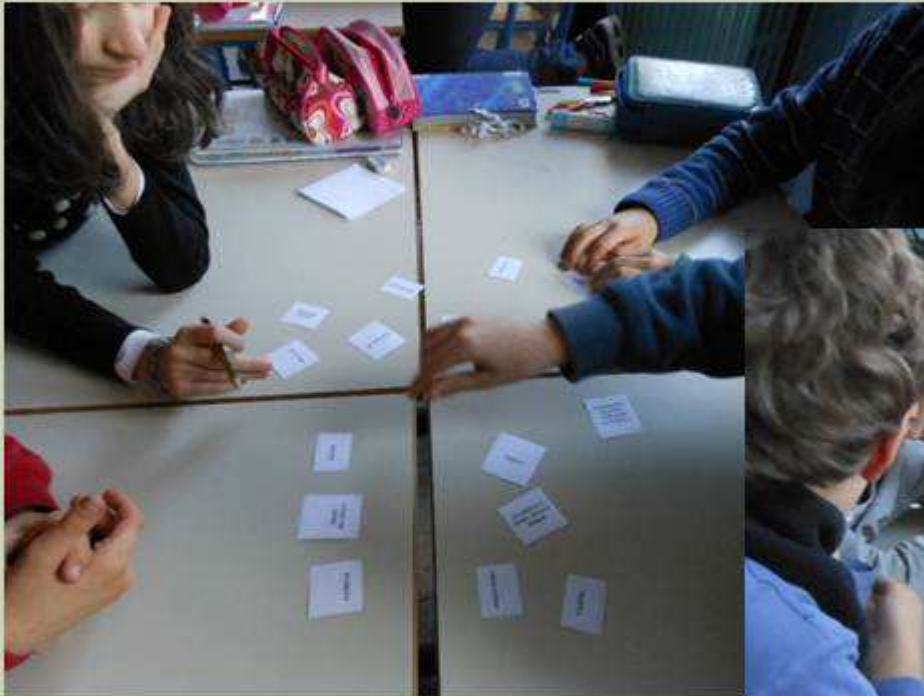


TH BEAR FROM ROMANIA: JIGSAW READING-
