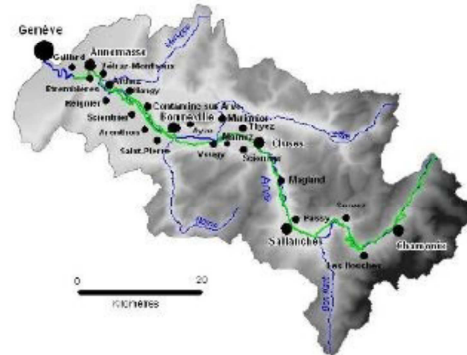


THE RIVER :

L'ARVE

The Arve river is 107 Km long.

Its source is at 2107 meters above the sea level, in the Mont Blanc.



It crosses only one region and many towns : Chamonix, Sallanches, Cluses. It has got 30 tributaries.

It flows to the lake Lemman in Switzerland, near Geneva . It's a tributary of the Rhône, which flows into the mediterranean sea.

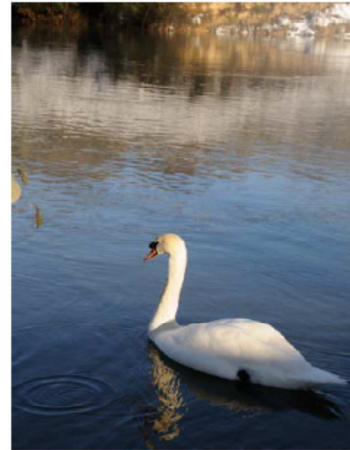


In the past, the river was often flooded. Now the river is damned, but beware of snowmelt !!!





Many animals live near the river : ducks, beavers, swans and fish like trout.
