

LISTENING WITH KEY WORDS

1. Cut the key words and put them in an envelope (one per group);
2. Students work in groups of 4. Each group opens the envelope and looks at the words;
3. Students are asked to form 3 groups: words we know/ we don't know/ we can guess;
4. The teacher asks each group, one at a time, to read the words they don't know and discover their meanings with the help of the other groups, dictionaries or web. Students are asked to guess which content the words are related to;
5. Playing bingo. Each student chooses 4 words and put them face up on the desk. The teacher calls the words – students put the words face down when they hear them from the teacher (this helps for the pronunciation of the new words). First ones to cover all the cards are the winners;
6. Listening with key words. Students keep their 4 words. The teacher reads the text below about the “eagle”. Students listen carefully: when they hear a word they have in their hands, they must put the words one below the other one in the centre of the group table.
7. As follow up activities, students can:
 - retell the text with the teacher help linking the words from the list (each group makes a sentence, taking turns)
 - use the words to fill in the gaps of the text about the eagle
 - use the words to write some sentences autonomously on the exercise book

Text for the teacher

- Eagles are big **birds**
