
DICTOGLOSS: LISTEN TO THE TEACHER AND COMPLETE

TEXT FOR THE TEACHER

The teacher reads the text and the students write the key-data in the right place in the diagram. The teacher can provide scaffolding by writing the key-words scattered on the board.

H. The Iberian lynx lives in **Andalucía**. It lives in **forests** and **mountains**

B. It has got a **short tail**, leopard-like **spots** and **light grey or brownish-yellow fur**.

The Iberian lynx is **smaller than** the **northern** lynx.

- F. It eats rabbits, hares and rodents.
- R. A lynx can have 2 or 3 kittens.

C. The lynx is in danger of extinction because of **change of habitat** and **few rabbits** surviving to illnesses.
