It **flows only through our** region, Thessaly across the towns of Trikala and Larissa. **It has 5 tributaries**. The route of the river is magnificent at some points: in the rocky mountains of Meteora; in the valley of Tempi where it flows between Mount Olympus and Mount Ossa before it forms its delta.



It has got many fish though it is quite polluted: trout, catfish, carb, and eel.

Pinios ends its flow into the Aegean Sea. Its delta is the widest point.

The delta of Pinios is a wetland famous for its **biodiversity**. It has 225 bird species which are rare or endangered, such as flamingos, swans, ergets and cormorants.
