The Tanaro River

The Tanaro is the **second i**mportant river in **Piemonte** region. It is **276 km long**.

The Tanaro **source** is in the **Saccarello Mount**, in Liguria region, on the borders with Piemonte.





It flows through **Liguria and Piemonte** and it **ends** into the **Po river**, the longest river in Italy.

Many animals live near the river Tanaro: herons, cormorants, rats ad "nutria".







You can still catch different kind of fish: carp, eel and chub.







Once boys used to swim and fishermen to fish at the river. Today Tanaro is **polluted**, there are few fish and very few fishermen spend their days on its banks.

The river Tanaro **flooded** the town many times in the past.

In 1994 an extraordinary wave flood destroyed the villages by the river in the valley were it flows.
