

The trout is a <b>middle-sized</b> fish. It can be 70cm long and it can weigh 1Kgr.  It has got a <b>big mouth</b> and a lot of <b>small sharp teeth</b> .  It has got <b>tiny scales</b> and <b>two soft fins</b> on its back; the second is smaller and it is close to the tail. <b>Younger</b> trout are <b>silvery</b> , but <b>older ones are grey-blue</b> or silver brown with little <b>black spots</b> all over their body.  They have also got a <b>pink-red side line</b> which helps them feel the danger.
Trout <b>live in ponds, lakes, rivers and streams</b> in fresh, cool water, rich in oxygen 10-16°C. You can find some trout in the sea, too. They don't spend their lives in one place, they like moving. Trout <b>change colors</b> when they move to different habitats.
The trout is an <b>omnivore</b> fish.  Young trout eat soft bodied aquatic insects and various species of zooplankton.  Old trout generally eat smaller fish, small worms, eels, lake plants, plankton and insects close to the water surface.  "The more fish the trout eats the largest trout it becomes!!"  The biggest trout recorded ever was 140cm and 50Kgr!!
Man is the worst enemy for the trout. Trout can live only in clear, fresh water.  It is a very delicious fish and there are a lot of recipes along the countries. In Greece it is considered to be the "king" of river fish.
