Trout are silver-brown or grey-blue with little dark spots.

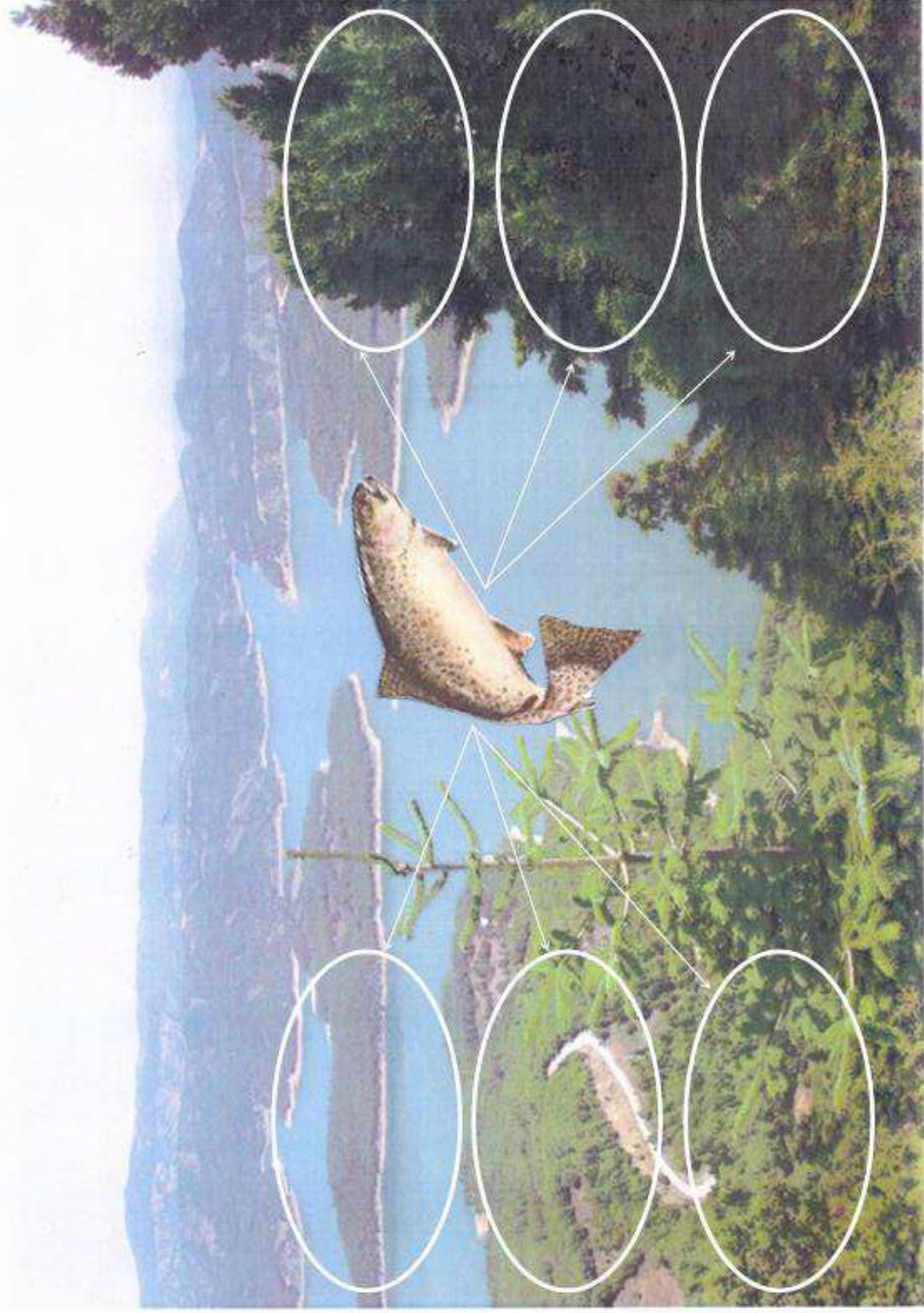



Read and give a title to paragraphs: *HABITAT – BODY – FOOD – TROUTS AND HUMANS*

	<p>The trout is a middle-sized fish. It can be 70cm long and it can weigh 1Kgr.</p> <p>It has got a big mouth and a lot of small sharp teeth.</p> <p>It has got tiny scales and two soft fins on its back; the second is smaller and it is close to the tail.</p> <p>Younger trout are silvery, but older ones are grey- blue or silver brown with little black spots all over their body.</p> <p>They have also got a pink-red side line which helps them feel the danger.</p>
	<p>Trout live in ponds, lakes, rivers and streams in fresh, cool water, rich in oxygen 10-16°C. You can find some trout in the sea, too.</p> <p>They don't spend their lives in one place, they like moving. Trout change colors when they move to different habitats.</p>
	<p>The trout is an omnivore fish.</p> <p>Young trout eat soft bodied aquatic insects and various species of zooplankton.</p> <p>Old trout generally eat smaller fish, small worms, eels, lake plants, plankton and insects close to the water surface.</p> <p>"The more fish the trout eats the largest trout it becomes!!"</p> <p>The biggest trout recorded ever was 140cm and 50Kgr!!</p>
	<p>Man is the worst enemy for the trout. Trout can live only in clear, fresh water.</p> <p>It is a very delicious fish and there are a lot of recipes along the countries. In Greece it is considered to be the "king" of river fish.</p>
